

## JB101/JB101XL/JB109/JB109XL Jack Bar Recommended Use



- Jack Bars should not be used with cargo on wheels. Cargo on wheels exerts more force when it shifts during movement and can cause friction type cargo bars to fail. Only use positive engagement shoring bars, beams or straps to secure cargo on wheels. Over tensioning of the ratchet mechanism may cause damage to trailer sidewalls.
- Cargo bars do not have a load rating due to varying conditions of trailer sidewalls.
- 1. Place fixed end foot against desired wall location.
- 2. Extend rack/extending foot to wall.
- 3. Use ratchet handle to tighten bar against wall, taking caution not to over tension and damage trailer side wall.
- 4. To release, disengage "UP" switch plate by pushing forward.
- 5. Use the ratchet handle to release pressure from the wall.
- 6. Use "Quick Release" tab to fully disengage rack section.
